The South African Animal Sanctuary Alliance (SAASA) is proud to say that we have been running ethical and responsible sanctuaries since 1998 – all of which remain open and flourishing. Our sustainable, award-winning sanctuaries are located along the Garden Route as well as in KwaZulu-Natal. Here is more information on our Garden Route sanctuaries, all situated in The Craggs, just outside the seaside town of Plettenberg Bay:

Monkeyland = World First and largest free roaming primate sanctuary hosting over 550 primates. At Monkeyland



you go on a 1 hour guided tour into our 12-hectare forest with one of South Africa's most professionally trained Monkey Safari Guides. The guides will attempt to find as many of the different species and give you ample time to take photos and ask questions. Different languages are available at times so please feel free to ask if we have yours available on arrival, best yet call ahead and book a language guide.

Birds of Eden = World largest single dome free flight aviary hosting over 120 species and nearly 1500 birds, walk on a self-guided tour through our 3-hectare aviary on our specially build boardwalks. Average time spend in the sanctuary range from 1 to 3 hours. A guided tour can be requested at no additional cost, if you are short of time or would like to make the most of your visit, please make sure to book ahead and ask for a Guide. There are no minimum pax required to have a guide available for your group/FIT's.



Jukani Wildlife Sanctuary = Enjoy an 80-minute walking tour with one of our experienced rangers, who will



"edutain" you with fascinating facts and stories about the animals. View and photograph them from raised platforms positioned throughout the sanctuary, offering excellent vantage points over the enclosures. You'll encounter many of the world's big cats, along with a variety of smaller wildlife. Each large, camp-like enclosure is designed to meet the animals' specific needs.

FootGolf@Monkeyland = Our newest addition combines the fun of football with the precision of golf! Play a round



on our beautifully designed 36-Par, 9-Hole FootGolf course set in the natural surroundings of Monkeyland and Birds of Eden. It's a fun, active, and family-friendly experience suitable for all ages and skill levels – perfect for groups, schools, and team-building days. FootGolf@Jukani opening end 2025!

Opening Times:

Monkeyland and Birds of Eden are open from 8am till 5pm
Jukani Wildlife Sanctuary opens at 9am and the last entry is at 3:45pm
FootGolf@Monkeyland first T-Time is at 8am, Last T-Time is at 4pm
We are open 365 days a year including all weekends and public holidays

Rate:

1 Sanctuary = R440 per adult / R220 per child
2 Sanctuaries = R704 per adult / R352 per child
3 Sanctuaries = R900 per adult / R450 per child
FootGolf @ Monkeyland – R100 per adult / R50 per child
Child rate is for children aged 3 – 12 years, 2 years old or younger are free of charge.
FootGolf is not recommended for those aged 3 or younger
These rack rates are valid from 1 January 2026 till 31 December 2026

Other: All Weather Facilities – we are open every day of the year, rain, or shine, if it rains you will get wet, but we will be open. We are Suitable for all ages and fitness levels – Disabled persons always enter our Sanctuaries Free of charge – we are wheelchair accessible in the animal sanctuary but not on the FootGolf course. We recommend (but this is not required): Long pants and comfortable walking shoes at all three sanctuaries, hats at Jukani and Footgolf as well as binoculars at Jukani and Birds of Eden.
